In-Person Worship Guidelines

We are so excited to be gathering in-person again! We want you to know that you and your family's safety is our priority. In order to keep people as safe as possible, here is what you can expect when you arrive.

Location

Our 8:30 service will be held in the main sanctuary, and our 11:00 service will be held in our Outreach Ministry Center (OMC), our gymnasium. Outdoor signs and greeters will help direct you to the best entrances.

Arriving at Church

When you walk into the building, a volunteer will record your name and phone number in the event that we need to contact you later regarding the gathering. It is not necessary to register in advance. If directed, please wait for one of our ushers to seat you and your family.

It is mandatory that masks are worn upon entering the building and remain on until you are seated. We also require that masks are worn at the dismissal of the service until you exit the building.

Physical Distancing

If an usher does not seat you and your family, we ask that you and those who arrive with you be seated at least 6 feet away from others, and we ask that you respect physical distancing guidelines during your visit.

Frequent Disinfecting

Our team is constantly wiping down surfaces and carefully sanitizing all used facilities before all services.

We do advise, if you are considered high-risk under CDC guidelines, or if you are feeling under the weather, that you would not attend the live services but plan to worship with our live stream at OaklandOnline.org. While these precautions do not eliminate all potential risk, as a church, we want to do everything possible to keep you and your family safe.
