Bible2School

Bible2School is a program that provides free elective Bible classes to elementary school students who attend public schools. They are bused to a nearby church or other location where trained volunteers lead them in worship and Bible stories. Their goal is that as they teach the Bible it will inspire hope and show the children their unique value in Christ. Currently there are Bible2School groups at Conemaugh Valley, Forest Hills, Greater Johnstown, Richland, and Westmont school districts. Child Evangelism Fellowship

Child Evangelism Fellowship is an international ministry in every region of our world that reached over 16 MILLION children worldwide in 2021 with the Gospel.

The vision is to reach EVERY CHILD, EVERY NATION, EVERY DAY which is done through local chapters like Cambria County using Good News Clubs, Children's Ministry Training, Christian Youth In Action, and VBS/5-Day Clubs.
